CAAC Athletic Director Meeting Minutes April 13, MHSAA Office

Schools Represented: Charlotte, Dewitt, East Lansing, Eaton Rapids, Fowlerville, Grand Ledge, Haslett, Holt, Ionia, Lansing Catholic, Lansing Eastern, Lansing Everett, Lansing Sexton, Mason, Okemos, Portland, St. Johns, Waverly, Williamston.

Hockey Schools met prior to the regular meeting to discuss plans for the 2022-2023 season. It was determined due to lack of players interested in high school hockey mid-Michigan will dissolve all existing cooperative agreement and pursue 2 cooperative agreements with Okemos and Dewitt being the lead schools. In addition, a request to waive the 5,500 student enrollment limit will need to be submitted to the MHSAA Executive Council.

Hockey plans were reviewed for the entire group.

All existing cooperative agreements that are up for renewal were approved. Moved by Waverly, supported by Eaton Rapids.

Final draft of the All-Conference procedure was presented following minor corrections this will be on the May agenda for approval and will be effective beginning 2022-2023 season.

Some minor revisions to the spring game sheets were discussed in addition to football pregame procedures. It was determined the teams should leave the field with minute minutes on the game clock to allow pre game band shows. If there is a deviation from that expectation the home school will communicate that in advance to the visiting teams.

The future of the CAAC Website was discussed. We will need to make a determination if we keep it or retire it.
