President Steve Baker called the meeting to order. November minutes were approved.

Chris Ervin shared and finalized plans for the CAAC Scholarship Competitive Cheer Meet at St. Johns on December 20th.

Final language for the basketball film exchange guidelines were presented.

Soccer and Volleyball coaches' meetings were held and feedback received was received to be considered as action items. Significant discussion was held in relation to All-Conference selection process, scheduling including game starting times and middle schools seasons. The Athletic Directors will act on these items in the January meeting.

Mike Conlin from the CAO A shared information regarding the completed football and current basketball season in relation to officiating. Mike Conlin shared the process of self-assigning and reviewed the addition of Laura Roberts as the CAO A scheduler. The CAAC affirmed its commitment to 7-man football crews.

Student admission prices was discussed as to some schools allowing free admission to for students to home athletic contests. Re-entry is an issue. The discussion moved to all admission policies regarding senior qualifications. The CAAC guidelines leaves the home school in control of admission policy but does recognize a senior and age 62 and above.

The CAAC Athletic Directors will defer any recommendations on youth football until after the MHSAA Executive Director, Mark Uyl states the position of the Michigan High School Athletic Association.

Commissioner Hunt will schedule additional fall coaches meeting after the new year focusing on football, golf and cross country.

Chris Henderson shared information regarding the Red/White Division Wrestling Tournament on February 8 at Williamston High School.
