CAPITAL AREA ACTIVITIES CONFERENCE MEETING MINUTES - December 18, 2025

The meeting was originally scheduled for 12.10.2025 and postponed to 12.19.2025 due weather and school closures.

The meeting was called to order at 9:34 AM

The Minutes from the November meeting were unanimously approved (Mason/Fowlerville).

Welcome Calvin Hissong the newly appointed Athletic Director at DeWitt High School.

House Bill #5154 currently in Committee would require all Michigan public schools to offer a cash option and free admission to seniors for all events when admission is charged.

The recent passing of Roy Kramer was acknowledged. Roy was the Commissioner of the Southeast Conference and former AD at Vanderbilt University. He was responsible for the Bowl Championship Series which was replaced by the college football playoff. Prior to these accomplishments Roy was the Head Football Coach at CMU and won a national championship in 1974. Before moving to CMU Roy was the Head Football Coach at East Lansing High School.

JV Wrestling- The first JV wrestling jamboree of the season was successful; most participants got 3 matches. Coaches were well informed of the format in advance.

A quote was shared for D&O Insurance protection for the CAAC. The protection will cost \$550 annually. **Motion to approve the expense made by Grand Ledge, seconded by Okemos. The motion carried unanimously.**

Financial update was tabled until January.

The Scholarship cheer meet will be held later today. AD's are asked to remind coaches warm up and practice space is limited.

AD's are asked to remind coaches of the basketball film exchange policy. CAAC schools shall provide access to 1 game from the previous week by noon Sunday prior.

Ken Sudall has asked for all baseball and softball schedules prior to the holiday break.

Chris Bishop pointed out that the survey function in final forms are required to be published. Use the term "feedback" instead.

Keith Cravotta reminded everyone of the Lansing School District spectator policy. Only students from the participating schools with valid student ID can attend.

CAAC Expansion-Tom reported that he has had further conversations with representatives from KLAA schools that have expressed interest in joining the CAAC. To have 3 schools approved would put the CAAC at 24 schools and would make it possible to have a fourth division. More to come in the coming weeks/months.

Sportsmanship Committee- The Sportsmanship Committee met and developed a statement to be used by public address announcers prior to CAAC events.

Office of Civil Rights Agreement- Tom reminded schools of the agreement made years ago that is still in effect and has no sunset regarding basketball schedules. The agreement requires CAAC schools to schedule boys and girls games at equally disadvantaged days and times. Schools that do not comply with the agreement do so at their own peril and that practice is not supported by the CAAC.

Lakewood will host JV Wrestling meet on Sunday, February 8, 2026.
