The meeting was called to order by Scott Casteele at 9:32 AM

The minutes of the January 18, 2023 meeting were approved.

Randy Allen presented a financial report. The CAAC stands in stable financial position and expenses are in line with projections.

Randy reported on cheer scholarships and CAAC Bowling Championships. Bowling and cheer division will be affected by the addition of our new schools.

A review of the officials appreciation week was discussed. NFHS will have spring appreciation week April 10-14, 2023. The CAAC will as well.
