CAAC ATHLETIC DIRECTOR MEETING MINUTES March 10, 2021 – Holt High School

Schools Represented: Charlotte, Dewitt, East Lansing, Eaton Rapids, Fowlerville, Grand Ledge, Haslett, Holt, Ionia, Lansing Catholic, Lansing Eastern, Lansing Everett, Lansing Sexton, Mason, Okemos, Portland, St. Johns, Waverly, Williamston.

The minutes from February 17th, 2021 meeting were approved.

Notes and minutes from the League and Conference meeting in Grandville were discussed. Most conferences are still dealing with COVID issues. Scheduling and officials shortage the dominant themes.

Some conferences will provide additional compensation to assigners for extra work. Some league will pay an additional 50%.

Conference Policy: Does anyone have policies to discipline schools that don't follow regulations? The OAA is looking for language.

Lansing schools requested approval for a cooperative agreement for softball. There will be one team from the 3 city schools. They will play in the red division, baseball will remain as separate teams-Cooperative agreement was approved.

Holt-Mason also requested approval of a cooperative agreement for girls lacrosse-Cooperative agreement was approved.

JV Golf schedules for spring were discussed. Who will be fielding teams?

Charlotte will sponsor freshman football in the fall of 2021.

Boys Lacrosse assigners are Jesse Read and Brian Fenney.

Boys lacrosse have requested increase of \$10 per official for varsity and \$5 per official for JV matches. In addition, a request to increase assigning fees from \$1,200 to \$1,600 per season.

Winter trophies and medals will be distributed following the meeting.

Senior Scholar Athlete release date will be May 15th. All schools are asked to keep their award winners confidential until May 15th.
