One Umpire pay policy was presented and approved. It reads as follows:

**Under Assigned (pay 1.5x)**

- If the games were originally assigned 1 official (despite 2 being anticipated), the single official should be paid 1.5x the rate.

### **No Show or Day-of Movement (pay 2x)**

- If the games were originally assigned 2 officials, and on the day of the game one official gets moved to a different game OR no-shows, the single official should be paid 2x the rate.
