CAAC ATHLETIC DIRECTOR MEETING MINUTES May 13, 2020-Zoom Meeting

Sub Varsity season ending tournaments will be held on Saturday, October 31, 2020. There will be two divisions for each JV and Freshman teams. The top 9 programs will play in the upper tournament and the bottom 10 teams will play in the lower tournament for competitive balance. Final standings will determine placement. Bottom 4 schools in the blue division and bottom 3 teams in the red and white divisions will play in the lower tournament. The upper tournament will involve the top 3 teams in each division.

Randy Allen requested some flexibility with regards to payment for cheer scholarship recipients due to Covid-19 and colleges on-line format. No opposition to that request was stated.

The CAAC Dues for 2020-2021 will remain \$3,000 per school.

Sparrow will pay the full sponsorship for the Senior Scholar Athlete Awards. \$2,000 will be applied to the 2021 event.

2020-2021 CAAC passes will be ordered and ready for schools by no later than August 1. Colors will be changed to differentiate from previous year.

The June golf outing has been cancelled due to Covid-19 concerns and restrictions.

Roles for Commissioner Hunt and Allen were discussed and only minor changes will be implemented for 2020-2021.

Brian Wolcott has a benefactor that has offered a billboard on the west side of Lansing to honor the 2020 graduating class from CAAC Schools. Hunt will collect school logos and help coordinate the company donating the billboard space.

The AD's will coordinate plans to get back to practice and comply with CDC, MHSAA, NFHS, State and local guidelines. It is understood that it will not be our decision if and when we can return but the responsibility will be ours as to how we will return to practice and training sessions. Renee Sadler will coordinate and assign specific sports to AD's so we can focus on how a return to activities might look for each sport.
