## **CAAC ATHLETIC DIRECTOR MEETING MINUTES November 13, 2019-MHSAA Building**

President Steve Baker called the meeting to order. October minutes were approved.

Associate Commissioner Randy Allen presented updated "sport sheets" for CAAC fall sports. AD's will review sport sheets with their appropriate coaches as well as the upcoming coach's meetings. Discussion continued as related to the pre- football procedures. It is the feeling of the Athletic Directors that teams leave the field during the band pre-games show and return for the national anthem. Schools are strongly encouraged to develop and provide pre-games itinerary to opposing varsity football teams.

Film exchange for basketball was discussed and it is the desire of the Conference to have game films shared within the CAAC. Commissioner Hunt provided some language that was modified by the group. The amended language is as follows: **"By agreement of the CAAC Athletic Directors league schools will share or allow access to a quality game recording of one game or scrimmage from the previous week to upcoming CAAC opponents. Coaches are responsible to provide recording by 12:00 PM the Sunday prior to the contest. This courtesy is not to be extended to non CAAC schools unless required by the MHSAA."**

Winter sports participation numbers were reviewed. As of the meeting date the following schools will only have two girls basketball teams. They are; Charlotte, Eaton Rapids, Haslett, Ionia, Lansing Eastern, Lansing Sexton, Mason and Portland.

Bowling schedules are available through the individual coaches a composite schedule is forthcoming. Delays are a result of conflicting schedules with bowling centers.

Chris Henderson introduced the format for a potential CAAC Individual wrestling tournament including all divisions. The tournament will identify the overall individual league champion in each weight class. Team Division Champions would be determined by the dual meet season.

All CAAC Wrestling Tournament was revisited. The Red and White division will hold a combined end of season tournament. Division Champions will be determined by dual meets. The Blue division will conduct a separate conference tournament. All CAAC schools have been invited to participate in a season ending JV tournament at Fowlerville High School on Friday evening before the division tournaments.

The December 4<sup>th</sup> youth football meeting was postponed until after the January 19<sup>th</sup> MHSAA meeting and position in relation to youth football.
