The minutes for the October 2021 were approved.

Commissioner Hunt congratulated fall teams from CAAC schools that finished in the top ten in MHSAA final standings and wished luck to CAAC teams still competing in fall tournaments.

A welcome to all administrative assistants was extended and a brief history of the formation of the CAAC was shared.

Senior scholar athlete awards will be held April 27, 2022 at Lansing Eastern High School. Alan Haller will deliver the keynote address.

Randy Allen distributed the first quarter financial report. The report was accepted and unanimously approved.

Much discussion over the All-Conference selection process continued and AD's that hosted meetings shared their experience. It is important to have more than one Athletic Director in attendance. The process in place is good, however minor adjustments and clarifications need to be made. It remains important the process beginning with the nomination procedure needs to be followed.

Sub-varsity volleyball tournaments held for the first time this year were reviewed. May need to tweak format but competitive levels were good and was a good culmination of the season.

Covid -19 protocols were discussed mask and testing will continue during winter sports especially in Ingham County schools.

Hunt shared topics of League Summit meeting including possible changes to football playoffs, 35 second clock in basketball.

Admission prices were discussed. A statement added to the CAAC guidelines stating additional charges for on-line ticketing may apply.

PA sportsmanship announcement was reviewed and distributed.
