CAAC ATHLETIC DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES - October 8, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 9:36 AM

Approval of September meeting minutes (Mason/Okemos) motion carried

Welcome CAAC Schools Principals and introductions of Principals and Athletic Directors

Sportsmanship - As basketball/indoor seasons approach the CAAC Spectator Expectations were reviewed for consistency among member schools and game administration. Signs are posted at most venues. More can be ordered if needed. When dual sites are scheduled and AD is at home does visiting school send game administration to assist in crowd control? Introduction should be made upon arrival to home school game administration.

Principals Topics - Get all of us in the same room and connect names with faces. Tom shared the historical perspective of the CAAC.

Principals asked how they can support Athletic and Activities Directors that are non-financial in nature.

Discussion of academic eligibility standards. Do schools have academic eligibility standards that exceed MHSAA criteria? Is it challenging to get up to date reporting of grades?

Boys Soccer Cup Review and Feedback - Games were covered by officials and good feedback was in place among schools and GLASRA. The coaches involved in the seeding process were very cooperative and collaborative. Seeding was completed 5 days prior to the beginning of the tournament. This allowed for more games to be completed for seeding and preparation for hosting and traveling.

Golf Championship - Red/Blue Feedback. It was good to get schools together and championship should be conducted at a neutral site. The course was challenging but arrangements were made to make the course more playable. Plans are being made to conduct all divisions of boys tournament the week of May 18.

Scheduling Meeting- The scheduling meeting will be held October 15 at Haslett High School. Spring schedules will be finalized.

Wrestling Schedules - need to be discussed at November Meeting emphasis on JV and girls wrestling.

Boys Lacrosse- A proposed Cooperative agreement for Boys Lacrosse was presented for approval. Holt will be the primary school and will include Lansing Catholic, Lansing Christian and Mason. Motion approved (Grand Ledge/Charlotte)
